SUBJECT: 2012 Short Term Capital Plan

Due to the slow economy and several extraordinary costs experienced during 2011, the FRRS is experiencing a cashflow shortage. The winter season was bridged thanks to a reduction in expenses, some new revenue and short-term (credit) borrowing. However, we need a more robust solution to address several needs, including bulking up the bank account and investment accounts, retiring outstanding large expenses and moving forward on several projects.

Outlined here is a comprehensive short term capital plan to address these issues and move ahead on recommended deaccession of equipment that has been deemed or is under consideration to be deemed surplus.

This plan is broken into two (2) sections: revenue and project / need. Each consists of three (3) phases which are dependent on each other: for example, Phase 1 projects are tied to the equipment to be sold / scrapped in Phase 1, etc. There is also a need to raise \$30,000 beyond the projected revenue targets for sales and / or scrapping.

As the revenue and cost numbers are projections, the projects / needs to be funded are listed in order of recommended priority. Of primary importance are Phase 1 items 1-3, which all relate directly to financial improvement. If revenue does not meet the projections, then projects will be removed in priority order from lowest to highest. Also, this plan is open to modification depending on need and income.

This plan is a short term item, bridging to a longer term full Business Plan which is currently under development. It supplements other revenue efforts currently underway or under development.

We recommend that the Board adopt this plan and implement it to provide for our near term financial needs. Implementation will be overseen by President McClure and Secretary Vicknair.
