SUBJECT: Funding

With assistance from Gail McClure, Frank Brehm and Wayne Monger, two grant applications have been submitted to the National Railway Historical Society and the Olive Smith Charitable Trust seeking a total of \$17,500 to benefit the archives and the proposed California Zephyr exhibit. Another three grants are in process to submit in the next month asking for \$70,000 to benefit the archives, the CZ exhibit and the "Charles O. Sweetwood".

Donations to the 2014 Spring Fundraiser have dropped dramatically. I will hopefully have totals from the fundraiser to report at the meeting. The letter for the Fall Fundraiser has been prepped with final work to occur in September for mailing in mid-October.

Wayne Monger and Debra Baer formally accepted the check for \$3,000 from the Union Pacific Foundation for the archives. Wayne also prepared a press release as requested by UPF. It is listed under his director report.
