Donation – Memorandum of Understanding

Donation by Bob Sims to WP 0-6-0 165 Tender Restoration

This Memorandum documents agreement by FRRS member Bob Sims to donate approximately \$5,000 via Stock Transfer to cover work on restoration of the tender for Western Pacific 0-6-0 steam locomotive 165. The financial details of this project can be found in Appendix A. The final donation amount will not be confirmed until the stock sold by FRRS.

The FRRS accepts this donation for the express purpose of work on WP 0-6-0 165 as outlined in Appendix A. When received, the funds will be directly placed into the Restricted Fund Bank account and credited to line item 40422 – WP 165 where it will be available solely for the described tender work. Any funds remaining upon completion of the outlined work will be made available for other 165 restoration work.

Financial accounting of this donation will be provided at least once every two months to Bob Sims by WP 165 program manager Chris Allan and FRRS Secretary Eugene Vicknair as needed until such time as the work being funded is complete and / or the funds of the donation are exhausted. A final accounting will be provided along with a progress report to close out the donation.

The donor acknowledges that no goods, benefits, services or special considerations are expected or will be provided in exchange for this donation.

The undersigned acknowledge that this memorandum outlines the scope of donation, restoration work and reporting as acceptable to donor Bob Sims, steam CMO Chris Allan and the FRRS.
