Big strides have been made this year thanks to your support and the hard work of our volunteers and the local community.

With an eye toward future growth, we have been working closely with Portola City Manager Robert Meacher on a series of meetings with local, state and federal political representatives, as well as a professional grant agency, to push our improvement plans into a higher gear. So far, the feedback from these elected officials has been spectacular and we have achieved a very high level of support for our future growth, including a recent meeting with California District 1 Representative Doug LaMalfa and his staff. One of the key points they saw was the ongoing support of our members and the professional and skillful work of our volunteers. Your continued and growing donations to the FRRS will not only fund immediate work, but will be seen as a vote to continue the growth of the organization and its mission.

We have seen some equipment work this year, with our mechanical crews have been working hard on WP F7A 917-A and Fairbanks-Morse H-12-44 1857 to improve their operations and condition. Both are key components of our RAL program. Our teams also came together to resurrect Southern Pacific bay window caboose 4706 from the burned out state we received it in to take a place in our caboose train. Especially during events like Santa Train, we were maxing out our capacity. SP 4706 gives us more space for riders and so far they love the new caboose.

The acquisition of our first display building is proceeding and will advance faster with the support of our membership and the local community. This is also a project we are working closely with the city and elected officials to achieve.

We continue to expand and improve our archives and move toward sharing more of them with the public. More film scans from the Virgil Staff Collection are being performed and we have spoken with some video producers about bringing these amazing films out on Blu-Ray and DVD.
