FUNDRAISING IDEA

Patty Clawson suggested that we could give a "second life" to some of our past convention presentation shows and also do some fundraising. The idea would be to have, maybe twice a year, a special presentation evening at the museum. Tickets would be limited to 30 or so people and they would receive a special tour, a historic presentation and have catered hor d'oeuvres and wine tasting.

For example, one of the evenings would focus on the Charles O. Sweetwood. Guests would get a special tour of the car, then a showing of an update of the presentation done for the 2013 convention is the Silver Plate. Others could focus on the SP Rotary, WP 805-A, the California Zephyr in general, etc.

These would take place after hours when no equipment is running. The Plumas Museum occasionally does gatherings like this where the guests get a historical presentation over hor d'oeuvres and wine as a fundraiser. One possibility is that we could cooperate with them on these evening presentations, splitting the proceeds. The Plumas Museum charges about \$65 per person for their events.

Would like input from the directors before pursuing this further.
