## Gentlemen:

At the recent WP convention in Salt Lake City, some conversations with Jeff Pierce suggested that you might be interested in carrying the Rio Grande Modeling & Historical Society quarterly magazine, "The Prospector" in the Portola Museum. Certainly both the WP and DRGW have a lot in common.

We currently have about 15 other major hobby shops and museums in the Midwest & West that carry this magazine and they currently sell from 6 to 24 copies each per quarter.

We currently distribute ~700 copies each quarter to members, hobby shops, museums and local train shows in Colorado, Utah & Wisconsin and would like to expand this to the Western Pacific area. Our interest is in both DRGW standard gauge and narrow gauge modeling and history which is reflected in a balance of well written and illustrated articles in this publication which typically runs 30-42 pages and currently retails for \$12/issue.

The Rio Grande Modeling & Historical Society would be pleased to add you to our list of hobby shops and museums carrying the Prospector magazine.

We believe that we can offer you favorable terms and would like to add you as our primary shop/museum in the WP area. We anticipate that you would exclusively be the source carrying this magazine in the Portola area. Our latest edition is Volume 17 issue 3 which was published in July 2018. Volume 17 Issue 4 will be going to press on October 15, 2018 and if you would like to confirm an order before 10/1 we can include you in the shipping of that issue. It will include articles on both standard gauge equipment and narrow gauge. Our editor, Dave Lotz, is dedicated to publishing 4 "on time" quarterly issues each year. Typically Jan, Apr, July & Oct.

## Our terms are:

4 Issues per year.

Minimum order = 6 copies

Dealer discount is 25% off the cover price which is currently \$12.00.

Our practice is to bill shortly after our printer ships prepaid directly to dealers and payment is due within 30 days.

Unsold, undamaged complete copies may be returned <u>at any time</u> to our Colorado Springs address for full credit applied to future shipments. Cover tear offs are not accepted for credit. The dealer pays the return postage.

You can cancel or adjust the number of copies of your standing order (6 copy minimum) at any time up to one week prior to us going to press, typically the 15th of the publication month.

All regular orders will be shipped prepaid directly via UPS from our printer, Ag Press, in Manhattan, KS and typically arrive several days before members receive their copies.

We also list you as one of our Prospector dealers on our website: www.rgmhs.org

We would like to suggest beginning with a standing order of 6 copies starting with Vol 17 Issue 4 and then we can adjust your order as needed as sales increase.

If you would care to order any back issues we can accommodate that also and would only require a minimum of 6 total copies on a single order. These would be shipped from our company store in Colorado Springs, CO.
