Treasurers Report

September 13, 2019 FRRS Board of Directors Meeting

Exciting news: A new speeder! Time to get ready for Pumpkin Trains. We are running trains and RALs.

Bank Accounts: Plumas Bank is still working well for us.

Available Cash: As of June 1, cash on hand of \$400, Plumas general checking \$6,327. There is \$23,182 in the Temp Restricted Account, savings \$386, Steam \$10,211 and \$42,605 in the endowment investment account. It continues to grow. Total in all savings and checking is \$42,974 plus the \$42,605 in the endowment fund. Store inventory is \$18,030.

Memberships: Membership dues so far this year \$13,845 vs \$17,178 in 2018. We need to improve this if we can. Patty Clawson has some good ideas for us.

Profit & Loss, year to date: Our net income for the year to date for 2019 is -\$17,680 compared with -\$-1,192 for 2018. Go RALs! We are still behind for the year.

Donations and Contributions: Totals are \$17,599 for 2019 vs. \$17,558 at the same time in 2018. Remember, there was a \$5,000 donation to move the PFE Reefer Car.

Museum Store, Sales and Admissions: Store sales \$21,432 in 2019 vs. \$19,337 in 2018. We are up! RAL income is \$24,675 2019 vs \$33,510 2018. Operations are \$28,914 income in 2019 vs. \$34,010 in 2018.

Expenses vs. Income: Total income so far this year \$129,805 vs \$136,313 in 2018. Expenses are \$147,485 2019 vs \$137,505 for 2018.
