First Use of mailtrain Tool

Working with Kerry Cochran and Eugene Vicknair, Kenneth Finnegan and I set up a new email tool for the society. It is called *mailtrain*. It allows bulk emails to be sent to a list of subscribers to share information about the museum and the society. When people use the online <u>Join/Renew tool</u>, there is a checkbox to request information about the FRRS by email. We have collected 116 email addresses from members who want informational emails that I used to populate a new "WPRM News" email list. I also manually added the nine board members to the list.

In each email, there is an "unsubscribe" option that the recipient can use to be automatically be removed from the distribution list. In addition to sending the emails, *mailtrain* reports if people unsubscribe, how many people actually open the email and how many actually click any links in the email.

After receiving permission from Kerry Cochran, on Monday, January 4, 2021, I used the new tool as a proof-of-concept exercise to send our approved *"2021 Closure Notice"* to 125 email addresses.

As part of the project, I created a <u>subscribe</u> tool that we can add to the website if we want that would allow members of the public to also join the "WPRM News" list. We can use this tool at no cost to the society. In the future, we can create additional lists to target other interests and needs.

2021

At the end of December and the first couple of days of January, I completed setting up the website for 2021. After discussions with Kerry Cochran and Greg Elems, we decided not to post the tentative FRRS Calendar for 2021 since the future is so uncertain. I replaced all the places on the website that normally link to the current year's calendar with a link to the approved 2021 Closure Notice. The 2021 Train Crew Signup page shows a message that the 2021 Train Schedule is TBD. The 2021 Crew Training Signup page shows the tentative crew training dates, but encourages members to use the same on-line training approach we used last year.

The FRRS/WPRM has a storefront at teespring.com that offers FRRS/WPRM themed products like coffee mugs, t-shirts and sweatshirts. The link to the storefront is at the bottom of the Latest Museum News Column on the society's home webpage. In 2020 we made \$160.88 profit on sales that has been credited to our PayPal account on 1/5/21 to be deposited into the FRRS General Fund.
