The 2022 Election Year is progressing well. Nominations have closed and a "White Ballot" has been declared. The confirmed nominees are existing Board Members Robert (Bob) Sims, Roger Stabler & Janet Steeper.

With the "White Ballot" declared the voting membership must be notified in writing of such. The following "White Ballot" postcard is being printed to be mailed to the FRRS voting Membership for petitioning:

"To the voting members of the Feather River Rail Society,

At the close of 2022 Board Election nominations, we have three candidates for the three open Board of Directors seats. By law, we are required to make notification of a potential "white ballot" election. In a white ballot, there is no mail-out election and the three candidates are automatically seated. This avoids the cost of mailing out ballots when there are an equal number of candidates to open seats.

While the time to submit candidate statements has passed, board eligible members are allowed to submit for a write in campaign up to March 15, 2022. If a member chooses to do so, they would be fiscally responsible for informing the membership of their campaign and getting members to write them in on the ballot.

This postcard is official notification of an impending white ballot and notice of deadline to submit for a write in campaign. The deadline is 11:59 PM on March 15, 2022 (postmark or email). Notice can be via email at <u>election@wplives.org</u> or via post mail at this address. Submit questions to election chair."
