

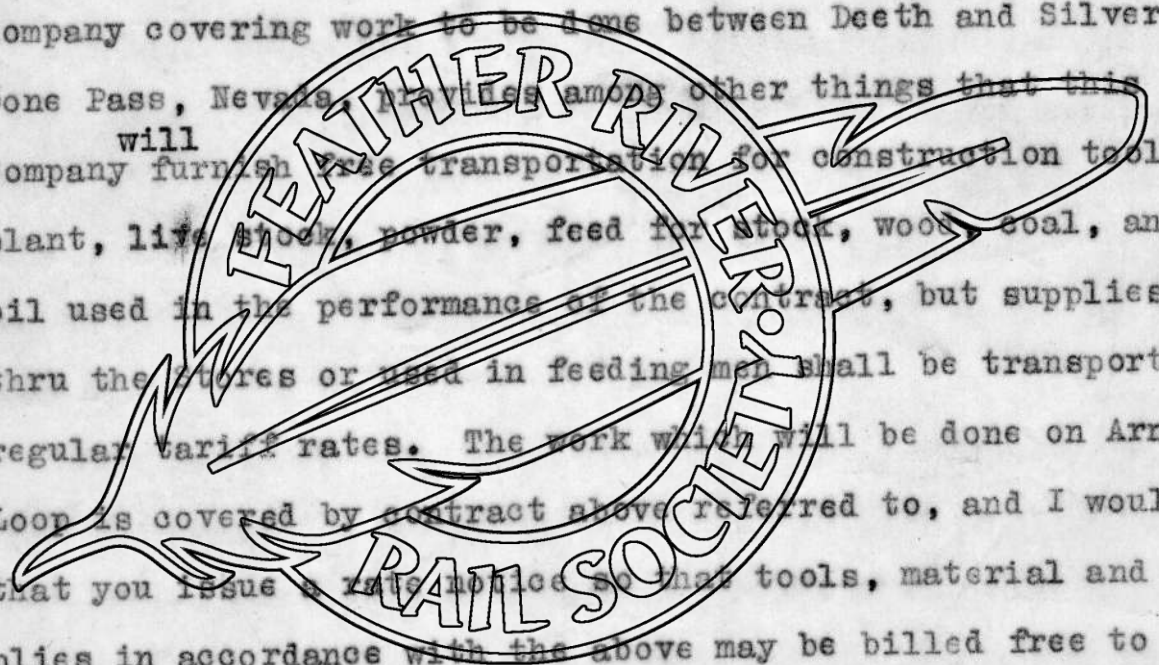

Dear Sir:

Our contract with the Utah Construction Company covering work to be done between Deeth and Silver Zone Pass, Nevada, provides among other things that this Company will furnish free transportation for construction tools, plant, live stock, powder, feed for stock, wood, coal, and fuel oil used in the performance of the contract, but supplies sold thru the stores or used in feeding men shall be transported at regular tariff rates. The work which will be done on Arnold's Loop is covered by contract above referred to, and I would ask that you issue a rate notice so that tools, material and supplies in accordance with the above may be billed free to Utah Construction Company, Care Western Pacific Railway Company from Salt Lake to Proctor and Silver Zone.
