

This Indenture, made and entered into this 15th day of November, 1905.



catituesseth, That for good and valuable considerations to each of the parties hereto received by and moving from the other, the receipts whereof are hereby respectively acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows, to wit:

That after the Contractor shall have commenced the work provided to be performed by it under the
