Sacramento was, of course, an important point throughout the Western Pacific's history. The railroad's main shops were located here until the Stockton Diesel Shop was built in the 1970's. After that, the Jeffrey Shops continued servicing freight cars. Sacramento was also home to subsidiary Sacramento Northern and was the

northern terminus for subsidiary Central California Traction Company. When the WP embraced Centralized Traffic Control, the dispatching center was located in Sacramento, right behind the depot at 19th and J Streets. The depot still stands today, housing a Spaghetti Factory restaurant.
