SUBJECT:

Silver Debris/Volunteer Lounge

Work has been progressing on the tear-out/prep of the Silver Debris outfit car following the Board's allocation of \$1000 to being work. The car will hopefully be ready for reconstruction work in the near future. We still need to finalize guidelines for its layout which will dictate how the various utilities are reinstalled.

It is proposed that the lounge would include:

Sofas/seating

- Dining seating
- Kitchenette (stove top, refrigerator, microwave, toaster oven, sink)
- Entertainment center (for donated TV, etc.)

The counters and refrigerator can be moved from the Shower car. Interior furnishing can be decided after major work is done on the car. Work required includes:

Insulation

- Electrical rewiring and upgrade
- Plumbing water and drain for sink (no restroom, these are available in shower car)
- Heating/Air Conditioning installation (can be installed later if utilities are in place)
- Carpeting

Extension of deck to car

Following demolition of the current interior we will commence with insulation and rewalling of the car. This includes lowering and insulating the ceiling. Concurrent with this will be the rewiring. John Walker has located a local contractor who is willing to assist with much of this work.

Eric Stephens has found a flooring contractor who is willing to assist and possibly donate all work on the carpet/floor. Most of the rest of the work can be done using volunteers. We have electrical and plumbing contractors willing to volunteer for those areas.
