## Correspondence

President McClure reported receipt of a licensing agreement from the UP which he is working on. He acknowledged receipt of a letter from the American Parkinson's Disease organization in Reno requesting donation of an RAL for their fundraiser. ### **New Business**

### **Budget Change**

Director Vicknair requested a temporary shift of funds from his available budget to facilitate completion of scheduled ADA walkway work. Alan Turner advised that a revised budget should be circulated once there has been a change to the adopted budget.

Motion # 04-03-02 - Shift of \$7,000 from budget line item 70005 - Fencing to 70005 - ADA Access. Motion made by Director Vicknair, seconded by Director Anderson. All Directors present voted in favor. Motion carried.

#### SP 0-6-0 1215

President McClure advised that he did not have the completed contract regarding the proposed sale of SP 0-6-0 1215. The Santa Clara Trolley and Rail Corporation, with whom the proposed sale is to take place, would like to make a public announcement regarding same.

Director Monger questioned if the individuals who donated to the restricted fund for the restoration of SP 1215 had been contacted regarding their donations. President McClure reported he, Director Holmes and Director Brehm were working on contact and the donors would be given a choice of return of their donation or placement toward another project.

Motion # 04-03-03 — Approve sale of SP 1215 for the amount of \$40,000 to Santa Clara Trolley and Rail Corporation subject to the terms and conditions of a contract to be approved by legal counsel. Motion made by Director Stiles, seconded Director Vicknair. All Directors voted in favor with the exception of Director Monger who abstained. Motion carried.

# **Historic Equipment Availability**

Director Monger reported he had been contacted by Jeff Moreau regarding two SP steel cupola cabooses and three 50' PFE refers. He provided a brief description of the equipment. The owners are reportedly looking at donating them to a "good home". The information regarding these items was referred to the A&D Committee.
