Dear Fellow FRRS Member,

2014 has been a building time after the financial trials everyone has seen over the last few years. As of the end of our operating season, we are running in the black, having reduced expenses and increased income versus last year. In addition to our increased sustainable income (sales, donations, etc.), we also sold several items of surplus rolling stock and some donated property, allowing us to bulk up our accounts and perform some needed projects.

Funds are now in hand to paint WP SW1500 1503, a project scheduled for early 2015. The Museum Store has received a lot of work and attention and looks better than ever. We also held a very successful Historical Convention that raised funds for the Archives and Library. By the beginning of next season, we will have placed new informational signage on over 15 pieces of equipment, with the hope of doing 15-20 more by the end of the 2015 season.

Work progresses on our steam engine, WP 0-6-0 165, with the goal of returning her to operation within the next two years. We have begun the large task of fencing the entire property, a project that will greatly increase the security of the museum grounds. There are also plans to add more walkways as well as completing the fencing in early 2015. We have also begun exploration of converting one of our baggage cars into an Archives Research and Work Room.

Of course, these projects rely on obtaining the funding to move them forward while still generating revenue to cover our everyday expenses. This is where your support comes in.

With the goal of moving ahead on some major projects next year, your support of the FRRS during the winter months means that we can hit the ground running once the snow melts. While our revenues slow way down after September, the expenses of maintaining the collections do not. So please help get ready for the coming year by donating today.
