Impossible Railways Video

On August 23rd, 2017, WPRM was contacted by a TV production company based in the United Kingdom interested in producing a documentary series including pieces of American railroad equipment. They traveled to California in September 2017 to produce a short segment about rotary snowplows. The piece would discuss the history of the rotary plow, how it worked and why it was such a successful piece of machinery. They came on the property on Saturday, September 16th for a day of living history. We provided an operating crew who demonstrated the equipment for the film crew. The operation ran for four hours.

On September 13th, 2018, Loren Ross reported he received a DVD in the mail from the United Kingdom, but it would not play on his DVD or Blu-ray players. The problem was the DVD was in PAL format (used in Europe) not NTSC (used in North America.)

Loren gave me the disk and I was able to convert it to NTSC format and made two copies for the society. I contacted TwoFour (the production company in the UK) and secured permission to use the video on our website. They limited usage to a maximum of three minute of video and required I include their copyright information and "used with permission" in the credits.

I created a two minute 56 second video using the material and posted to our WPRM Photo & Video Gallery as <u>The Ultimate Snow Clearing Machine</u>.

Now for the bad news; nowhere in the whole DVD or in the credits of the video is there any mention of the FRRS, WPRM or where the video was created. Therefore, the museum and society achieved NO PUBLICITY from this effort.

I suggest if we ever do something like this again, we put in the written agreement that the name of the society and museum will be included in the video and/or credits. There is no way for anyone who watched the original broadcast to know anything about us or where we are.
