
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SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT ACCOMPANYING CONTRACT "E."

This Indenture, made and entered into this 15th day of November, 1905.



continues to each of the parties hereto received by and moving from the other, the receipts whereof are hereby respectively acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows, to wit:

That after the Contractor shall have commenced the work provided to be performed by it under the

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terms of a contract between the parties hereto dated the 15th day of November, 1905, wherein and whereby the Contractor undertakes to do and perform all the clearing, grubbing, grading, tunneling, masonry, pile and trestle bridging, construction of culverts, ditches and creek channels, and such other work connected therewith or rendered necessary thereby in order to complete and make ready for the laying of track upon that portion of the line of allroad of said RAILWAY COMPANY as the staked Dout and ocated between a point of Myers Street, distance of twenty-six miles erest to the Contwentieth day of each about the equal to fifteen onth, a sum per centum of the cost price fart of the said work estimated by the Chief Engineer of the RAILWAY have been performed by the Contractor delegar month, but upon the CONTRACTOR will give its nonnegotiable Promissory Note or Notes, in the usual and ordinary form, wherein and whereby it shall agree to pay to the RAILWAY COMPANY, at its office in San Francisco, California, said sum of money so loaned, without interest, on or before the 1st day of October, 1906; but,

Note or Notes shall be guaranteed in writing on the back thereof by E. B. Stone, or such person or persons as may be satisfactory to the Chief Engineer of the Railway Company, the contract of guaranty to be in such form as will be approved by the Chief Engineer of the Railway Company; and

Provided. en the Chief Engineer shall said loan him that of said work, both, u been paid in full all tractors, have nd Asor done and materials furnish work Oconnecsaid work to the date Chief certificate for the work duning the preceding calendar month

cept in lieu of said evidence of payment a bond satisfactory to him (the Chief Engineer) to hold the RAIL-WAY COMPANY harmless from any claim of lien by such person who has not been paid in full.
