For All Visitors to the
Western Pacific Railroad Museum

CAUTION: "Trains may move at any time, on any track, in either direction, without warning."

You and your party are responsible for your own safety. Constant presence of mind to ensure safety to you and all members of your party is a primary duty while visiting us.

Persons should never climb under, on top of, or go between any equipment. When getting on and off of equipment (e.g. a locomotive), climb up or down the stairs or ladder with your body facing the locomotive or caboose. And please, do not use the rail as a balance beam!
