


Baldwin Switchers

**US Steel 16, Baldwin-Lima-Hamilton,
Model S-12, Builder Number #75912,
Built 10-53.**

Built for McCloud River RR as their No. 30.
Sold to Rayonier, Inc., WA, renumbered
203, sold to US Steel renumbered 16.
Painted bicentennial 1776 in 1976.



**US Steel 17, Baldwin-Lima-Hamilton,
Model S-8, Builder Number #75834,
Built 1-54.**

Originally constructed as the cab unit of a
cow and calf set in April 1953 on the basis
of an order from Oliver Iron Mining. They
were painted and lettered for that company
and given road numbers 1216A/B. The set
was never delivered. The cab unit was sold
to Armco Steel in Ashland, KY in Jan. 1954
as their No. 1201.



**US Steel 20, Baldwin-Lima-Hamilton,
Model S-12, Builder Number #76091,
Built 2-55.**

Built as Armco Steel No. 706.
