The WPRR Museum operates passenger trains every weekend from Memorial Day through Labor Day, and some additional "special" trains along the way, including our October *Pumpkin Trains*, and our December *Santa Trains*. Begin your journey with us as you become a student brakeman in our in-house training program. Certified instructors will teach you the basics of railroading, including instruction on coupling and un-coupling cars, hooking up brake air hoses, giving hand signals to the engineer, and throwing switches to change tracks.

To get started, you must first join the Feather River Rail Society and then attend one of two annual training classes where you'll begin your official training. This year the classes will be held Saturday May 9 and Saturday May 23 at 10:00 a.m. You will receive in-depth instruction and take a rules examination. Not to worry, the test is "open book". You'll also be asked to provide an emergency notification form and sign a Liability Release. Upon completion of the training class, you'll be an official member of the Operating Department. Your future career begins as a Student Brakeman and you can work your way up the ranks to Conductor, Fireman, and finally Engineer. "WP" also stands for Willing People. We need people who are willing to help keep the Western Pacific alive for years to come. COME JOIN US!!
