Under the culvert work contemplated for 1941, it is proposed to extend the present 36-inch culvert at M.P. 316.20 down over the bluff at this point, at the outlet end.

Please arrange to make necessary survey to determine what additional length will be required in order to carry the water down the face of the bluff and prevent spray and backwash from the outlet cutting away the toe of the present fill.

Also arrange to make survey 40 feet east of M.P. 111 on the N.C.E., where it is proposed to install a 24-inch corrugated iron culvert 24 feet long. This culvert is to empty into the ditch at the outlet end, and your survey should determine the location and extent of the necessary ditch.

Please arrange to make these surveys at your earliest opportunity in order that we may prepare necessary plans and estimates.
